**Statement by
Brett Earl, co-owner of Earl Fisher BioFuels LLP
Release of *Homegrown Prosperity from the Bottoms Up*
March 12, 2009**

Earl Fisher BioFuels LLP (EFB) is a partnership between Brett Earl and Logan Fisher. Brett and Logan are both fourth generation Montana farmers. They are concerned about the agriculture economy, but hopeful for their small communities and state. Brett and Logan have education and experience in: production agriculture, chemical engineering, sales, marketing, finance and management and have set out to use these skills for the betterment of their community in and around Chester. EFB is committed to producing a high quality, ASTM-6751 certified B100 fuel.

Earl Fisher BioFuels believes biodiesel can be a community based decentralized energy production model. EFB has set out to prove this model. The mission at Earl Fisher BioFuels is to create economic growth and employment opportunities by building a biodiesel production facility. This will in turn build a self sustaining industry by creating a market for oilseed crops that can be grown locally, converted to fuel locally, and consumed locally. Their long term plan is to duplicate the process in other small communities throughout the state, making the Chester facility the benchmark and training facility for all future locations. The final production goal for this location will be 1,000,000 gallons per year. The current capacity is 275,000 gal.

In the process of building the facility and manufacturing fuel, Earl Fisher BioFuels has employed as many as five full time and part time people. Our three to five year goal was to create an opportunity for 2 to 3 employees. We achieved this goal in our first year of production. Our seven to ten year goal is to create an opportunity for 6 to 10 employees. In our community of 900 people this is significant economic development.
